<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Implement automated testing to improve efficiency and accuracy.</li><li>• Conduct regular customer feedback sessions to better understand user needs.</li><li>• Schedule weekly cross-functional meetings to ensure alignment between teams.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Overload team members with too many tasks, leading to burnout.</li><li>• Rely solely on manual testing, which is time-consuming and error-prone.</li><li>• Delay code reviews until the end of the sprint, causing bottlenecks.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Encourage open communication and collaboration among team members.</li><li>• Use Agile methodologies to manage our sprints effectively.</li><li>• Provide regular training and development opportunities to stay updated with industry trends.</li></ul>
